Neostigmine	Vascular and interstitial
Barbiturates	Vascular and interstitial and intercellular
Thiopental	Highly lipid soluble drug ( redistribution)
Aspirin+amiodarone	Displace warfarin
Chloroquine	Concentrated in liver
lodides	Concentrated in thyroid and salivary glands
Quaternary ammonium	Ionized
compounds	Poor absorption
