Types of epithelium:

The eye

The corneal epithelium : 5-6 layers

- Basal —> columnar
- 3-4 intermediate—> polyhedral cells
- The surface corneal cells —> squamous

- mucus layer of Tear film forms a network over the conjunctival surface, secreted by —> the stratified squamous cells of the conjunctive
- Corneal endothelium —> simple squamous cells
- Limbus —> stem cells
- Posterior surface of iris = anterior epithelial surface of ciliary body —> made of 2 layers of pigmented cuboidal epithelium
 - The dilator pupillae muscle —> myoepithelial cells partially pigmented
 - The sphincter pupillae muscle —> circular band of smooth ms
- Lens epithelium —> single layer of cubical cells

• Pigmented epithelium layer of retina (first layer) —> Single layer of cuboidal cells with basal rounded nuclei


• Bulbar conjunctiva —> Formed of st. columnar epith with gobletlike cells

Eye lid

- From <u>outside</u> is covered e thin skin that has no subcutaneous fat.
- from <u>inside</u> is lined with palpebral conjunctiva.
- Lacrimal canaliculi —> Lined with stratified squamous epithelium
- Lacrimal sac —> wide tube, lined with pseudo- stratified columnar ciliated epithelium (motile cilia) & goblet cells

The ear


- External auditory canal —> lined with keratinized stratified squamous epithelium
- Tympanic membrane (ear drum) :
 - Outer layer : keratinized Stratified squamous epithelium devoid of hair
 - Intermediate layer: collagenous fibrous layer
 - Inner mucous layer: simple cuboidal epithelium



• The Middle Ear (tympanic cavity) —> Lined with simple cuboidal epithelium

- Eustachian tube :
 - Bony part (tympanic) —> lined with simple columnar ciliated epithelium

- Cartilaginous part (pharyngeal)—> lined with respiratory epithelium
- Scala media (Cochlear duct):
 - a. The lateral wall —> covered with stratified columnar cells
 - **b.** The roof —> covered on both sides with simple squamous epi
 - c. The floor —> its under surface covered e simple squamous epithelium



• The utricle & saccule —> simple squamous epithelium
