#### Blood

- WBC = 22, Platelets =
   298, RBC = 4.5, Na = 136,
   K = 3.6, glucose = 95
- Urine:
  - RBC = 2-4, protein = +1, PH = 5.5
- CSF:
  - Protein = 110
  - Glucose = 2
  - WBC = 1000 (90 % neutrophile)

#### Case study

A 6 weeks old male presented to the Emergency Room with fever, poor feeding.on physical examination there was bulging fontanelle. CSF test shows presence of neutrophils, increase protein,low glucose level

- 1-What is the most likely diagnosis? acute Bacterial meningitis

- 3- Management? ampicinin + Cetotaxime.

- -> hydro cephalus, hearing Loss, mental retardation


#### Case study




