

# **Abdominal Pain History Checklist**

## Opening the Consultation (Patient's profile) (Score: 1/10)

- 1. Introduction: Introduce yourself and your role.
- 2. **Consent**: Explain the purpose of the history taking and obtain consent.
- 3. **Patient's Profile**: Take the necessary information from the patient such as his where he lives, Martial status & Occupation.

# **Presenting Complaint (Score: 1/10)**

4. **Open Question**: Ask the patient to describe their abdominal pain in their own words.

### **History of Presenting Complaint (Score: 4/10) (SOCRATES)**

- 5. **Site**: Ask where the pain is located.
- 6. Onset: Clarify when the pain started and whether it was sudden or gradual.
- 7. **Character**: Ask the patient to describe the nature of the pain (e.g., sharp, dull, cramping).
- 8. **Radiation**: Inquire if the pain radiates to other areas (e.g., back, shoulder).
- 9. **Associated Symptoms**: Ask about symptoms like nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, constipation, fever, or bloating.
- 10. **Timing**: Determine the duration and pattern of the pain (e.g., constant, intermittent).
- 11. **Exacerbating/Relieving Factors**: Ask what makes the pain worse or better (e.g., eating, bowel movements, medications).
- 12. **Severity**: Use a scale of 0-10 to gauge the intensity of the pain.

#### Systemic Enquiry (Score: 1/10)

- 13. **Gastrointestinal**: Ask about other gastrointestinal symptoms (e.g., changes in bowel habits, blood in stool).
- 14. **Urinary**: Inquire about urinary symptoms (e.g., dysuria, hematuria).
- 15. **Gynecological (if applicable)**: Ask about menstrual history, vaginal discharge, or pelvic pain.
- 16. **General (B-Sx)**: Inquire about general symptoms like weight loss, fatigue, or appetite changes.

#### Past Medical History (Score: 1/10)

17. **Gastrointestinal Diseases**: Screen for conditions like peptic ulcer disease, inflammatory bowel disease, or previous abdominal surgeries.



- 18. Other Relevant Conditions: Ask about diabetes, hypertension, or other chronic illnesses.
- 19. Surgical History: Inquire about any past surgeries, especially abdominal.

## **Drug History (Score: 1/10)**

- 20. **Current Medications**: Ask about all current medications, including over-the-counter and herbal remedies.
- 21. Allergies: Inquire about any drug allergies and the nature of the reactions.

### Family History (Score: 1/10)

22. **Gastrointestinal Diseases**: Ask about family history of gastrointestinal conditions like colorectal cancer or inflammatory bowel disease.

# Social History (Score: 1/10)

- 23. **Smoking**: Take a detailed smoking history.
- 24. Alcohol: Inquire about alcohol consumption.
- 25. Recreational Drugs: Ask about the use of recreational drugs.
- 26. Diet: Discuss dietary habits and any recent changes.
- 27. **Recent travel History**: Ask the patient if he has traveled in the last 2 years to another country.

# **Closing the Consultation (Score: 1/10)**

28. **Thank You**: Thank the patient for their time and cooperation.
