

# **Abdominal Physical Examination Checklist**

## Opening the Examination (Score: 1/10)

- 1. **Introduction**: Introduce yourself and your role.
- 2. **Consent**: Explain the purpose of the examination and obtain consent.
- 3. **Positioning & Privacy & Lightning**: Ensure the patient is comfortably positioned, lying supine with their abdomen exposed. (1P)

### **Inspection (Score: 2/10)**

- 5. **General Appearance**: Observe the patient's general appearance and any signs of distress.
- 6. **Abdominal Contour**: Inspect the shape and contour of the abdomen.
- 7. **Skin Changes**: Look for any skin changes, scars, rashes, or striae.
- 8. Visible Pulsations or Peristalsis: Note any visible pulsations or peristalsis.

#### Palpation (Score: 4/10)

- 9. **Light Palpation**: Perform light palpation in all four quadrants to assess for tenderness, guarding, or masses. (1P)
- 10. **Deep Palpation**: Perform deep palpation to further evaluate for masses or organomegaly. (1P)
- 11. Liver Palpation (Liver span): Palpate the liver edge.
- 12. **Spleen Palpation**: Palpate for splenic enlargement. (Ride side maneuver)
- 13. **Kidney Palpation (Ballottement & Bimanual)**: Palpate for kidney enlargement or tenderness.
- 14. **Aortic Palpation**: Palpate the aorta to assess for aneurysm.

#### Auscultation (Score: 1/10)

- 15. **Bowel Sounds**: Listen for bowel sounds in all four quadrants.
- 16. **Vascular Sounds**: Auscultate for bruits over the aorta, renal arteries, iliac arteries, and femoral arteries.

#### Special Tests (Score: 1/10) (17 & 18 are mandatory while the others are extra)

- 17. **Shifting Dullness**: Assess for shifting dullness to evaluate for ascites.
- 18. Transmitted Thrill: Asses for transmitted waves to evaluate for SEVERE ascites.

#### **EXTRA**:



- 19. **Rebound Tenderness**: Assess for rebound tenderness to evaluate for peritonitis.
- 20. Murphy's Sign: Check for Murphy's sign to assess for cholecystitis.
- 21. Rovsing's Sign: Evaluate for Rovsing's sign to assess for appendicitis.
- 22. Psoas Sign: Test for psoas sign to evaluate for appendicitis.
- 23. **Obturator Sign**: Test for obturator sign to evaluate for appendicitis.

**Closing the Examination (Score: 1/10)** 

- 26. DON'T FORGET DRE, FEMORAL ORIFICES, INGUINAL LYMPHNODES
