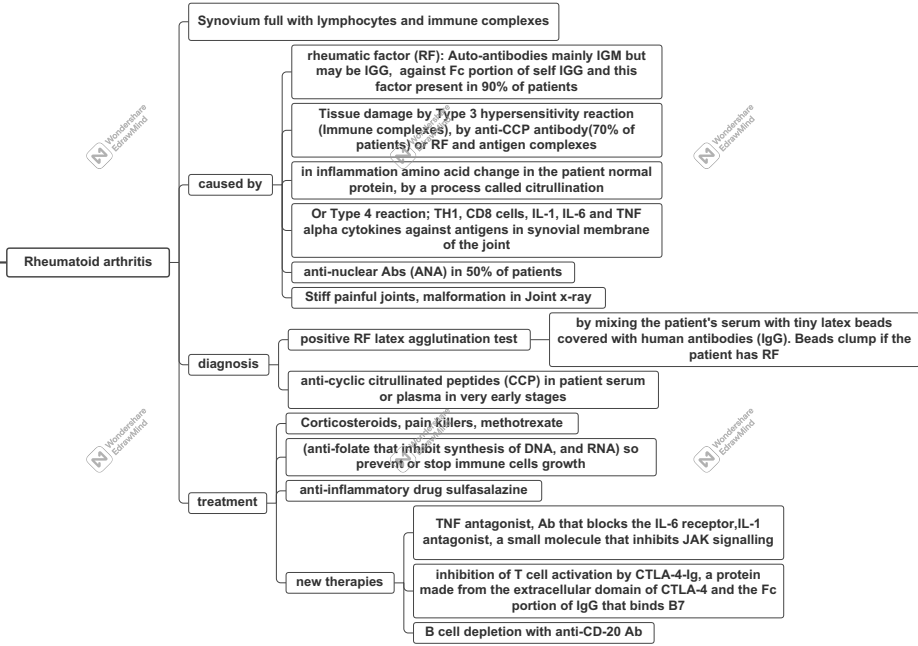
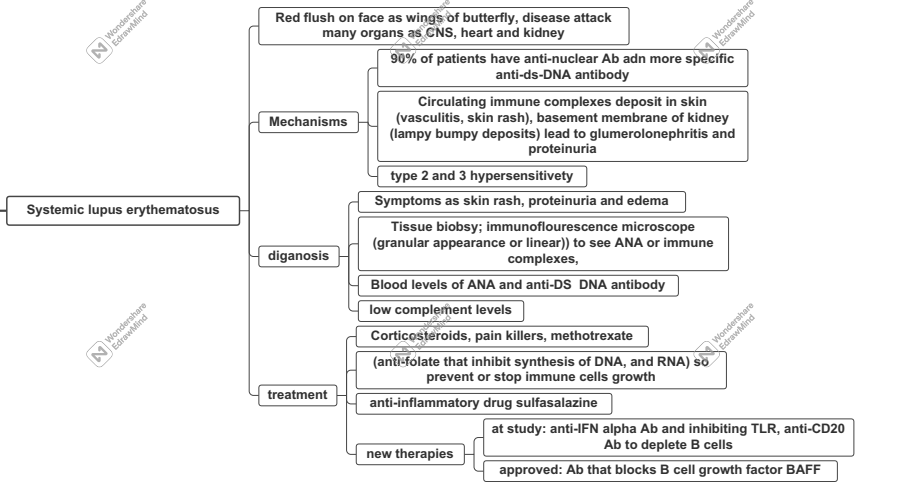


Connective tissue diseases



Scleroderma – an activation of immune cells that produces scar tissue in the skin, internal organs, and small blood vessels. Lead to tight skin appear in fingers and chest

Sjögren's syndrome – also called Sjögren's disease, is a chronic, slowly progressing inability to secrete saliva and tears.

Mixed connective tissue disease (MCTD)

- is a disorder in which features of various connective-tissue diseases (CTDs) such as systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE); scleroderma
- is considered an intermediate stage of a disease that eventually becomes either SLE or Scleroderma.

Psoriasis in psoriasis is over growth of the skin
