* What is the best sign of fat embolism? ~~Low level of consciousness~~

① Anemia ② Thrombocytopenia ③ Diffuse petechial rash

* Amniotic fluid embolism

1. Rare 2. Dangerous 3. High fatal ≈ 80%

* Infarction → Red → hemorrhagic
White → anemic

* Infarction → microbial present → septic
microbial absence → bland

* Organ with dual supply: Liver, Lung, hand, small intestine, forearm

* Organ with end-arterial circulation: Kidney, spleen, heart

* Neurons damage after 3 → 4 min

* Myocardial cell die after 20 → 30 min

* Fibroblast remain viable after many hours of ischemia
