

**Accessory obturator nerve**


An occasional branch of the lumbar plexus

Only found in 12% of subjects

It descends close to medial ligament

It gives branches to pectineus and hip joint

**obturator nerve (L2,3,4)**



The anterior branch descends in front of the adductor brevis and behind adductor longus and pectineus.
