commercial aviation

- In health care, it is not uncommon that patients are exposed to harmful ^{risks} _{risks}.

risk → predictable \Rightarrow informed consent is obtained.

unpredictable \Rightarrow Medical errors \Rightarrow informed consent can't be obtained.

failure of a planned action
To be completed as intended.
preventable adverse medical offense.

includes all faults in medical practice leading to remaining harm or permanent infirmity.

- lack of rational degree of care & skill

good experience

causes \rightarrow Negligence \rightarrow ↓ care.

causes \rightarrow Incompetence \rightarrow ↓ skill & medical knowledge

It's a commitment by me to do my best of care & skills for the benefit of the patient

Negligence

- Inadequate standard of medical care given to a patient

omission

failure to do something \rightarrow _{not to do}

commission

doing something wrong

contributory negligence

- patient ignores the advice of his doctor partially
- might loss his right to claim damage totally if harm results

Incompetence

- failure of the doctor to offer necessary degree of skill resulting in injury to the patient.

causes

- distraction
- fatigue
- lack of education & experience
- inadequate attention given to individual patient
- inaccurate medical records

types of malpractice

technical fault

Dr. doesn't follow the scientific basic rules in his profession for diagnosis & treatment.

major
minor

objective mistake

when a surgeon forgets any object inside a surgical wound. \rightarrow towel, instrument.

→ major

Most legal action → civil law

Few → criminal prosecution

↳ illegal abortion.
death of a patient
resulting from gross
ignorance or negligence.

legible case

- ① mistake.
- ② damage or harm
- ③ causative relation
between the mistake & harm.

The basis of evaluating the malpractice

① The professional level of the physician.

[GP] can't be considered negligent because a [specialist] must have served a patient better.

② Severity of the case

③ The time & place of the act.

④ A medical injury may have been caused by any or more of the medical personnel who have treated the patient.
