

The internal jugular vein

- ❖ At the level of the sternoclavicular joint, the internal jugular vein unites with the subclavian vein to form the brachiocephalic vein.
 - ❖ The internal jugular vein receives several tributaries, including:
 - Inferior petrosal sinus
 - Pharyngeal vein
 - Common facial vein
 - Lingual vein
 - Superior thyroid vein
 - Middle thyroid vein
 - Occipital vein
